If you can get your hands on Princess Hats or Princely Crowns for the students this is an added plus. A visual goes a long way in getting the subject at hand into the mind.


Message Points:

1. *Wouldn't it be nice:*

 - Better than a house.

 - Better than Windsor Castle in England even.
 - I MEAN NICE.
- † You'd have the best of clothes:
 - I am talking NICE.
 - Not something from the Goodwill Store.
 - Better than Wal-Mart.
 - Better than JC Penny.
 - Better than the fanciest store in NYC.
 - Better than the fashions of Paris, France.
 - I MEAN I AM TALKING NICE.

2. *Imagine heir to privileges of the KING:*

- † Think of all the riches of the king at your disposal.
- † Think transportation.
 - I am talking Finest Horses; Finest Chariots
 - Nicest Wheels available.
 - NEWEST Sports Car of the year.
 - I'm talking new one each year, no, I am talking one for each day.
 - Finest Riches
- † Think Protection. Nobody would talk down to you. You are the King's Kid. You could tell your Dad when the "bullies" get after you. He would have that taken care of.
 - Your own Personal Body Guards.
 - He would send a Messenger to alleviate or annihilate the problem.



3. What a Place/Position in the Kingdom!:

- † Your dwelling place/ your own room in the palace.
- † Your finest clothes.
- † Finest transportation.
- † Body Guards
- † Oh, and let's not forget all the best food !
