ACT ONE:

Characters: Zorro type character

Sheriff Big Hat Cowboy

Cowgirl Heroin

Silly the Kid/ Villain [Act Two & Three]

Background Music Up: Suggest the Original *The Legend of Zorro Soundtrack* .
Running the music for at least 60 seconds sets the mood.

Sheriff: *[Dressed in Cowboy Hat & an obvious STAR on his chest]*
A Wild Wild West town like Tombstone is SO hard to control.
I got Bank Robbers; I got Horse Thieves; I even got Chicken Thieves.

Cowgirl: *[Riding in on her horse swiftly OR running in.]*
Where's the Lawman? Where's the Lawman?

Sheriff: Why do you want to know?

Cowgirl: Are you the Law Man?

Sheriff: Welllll, maybe I am and maybe I ain't; depends on why you are a askin' !

Cowgirl: Cause SILLY THE KID is on his way to Tombstone.
AND HE'S NOT COMING FOR PIZZA!

Sheriff: In that case; I haven't seen the Lawman.

Zorro: *[QUIETLY arrives on scene]*

Sheriff: *[Turns to notice Zorro]*

OH GREAT! Another robber !

Zorro: Looks can be deceiving, Sheriff Big Hat.

God looks on the heart, not on the outward appearance.

I am no thief.

Cowgirl: *[Approaches Zorro and tries to mess with his mask]*

ZORRO, is that you?!

Zorro: Yes, I am here to tell you not to fear Silly the Kid because the Bible, God's Word, says " Even the very hairs of your head are numbered. Fear not therefore..."

Sheriff: *[Is MIS-COUNTING the hairs on his head]*

1,2, 4, 5, 8...no no ahhh 1, 2,

Cowgirl: *[Turns toward Sheriff with her back to Zorro]*

WHAT are you doing?

Zorro: *[Sweeps his cape, Zorro style; Raises his sword.]*

I'll be back next Sunday to deal with Silly the Kid.

Background Music Up: Suggest the Original *The Legend of Zorro Soundtrack* .
Running the music for at least 60 seconds sets the mood.

Sheriff: Last Sunday we heard that Silly the Kid was coming to Tombstone;
AND IT WASN'T FOR PIZZA.

Cowgirl: *[Riding or Running in]*
He's a COMIN'
He's a COMIN'
Everybody off of the streets!
[Rides or Runs out]

Silly/ Kid: *[Dressed with slouchy sloppy look of young gunslinger carrying an obviously large BAG of Fritos and munching.]*
[Walks slowly up to Sheriff Big Hat]

Sheriff: Sssssssiiiiiiiiilly the Kid?

Silly/Kid: Yeah !

Sheriff: What are you doing in Tombstone?

Silly/ Kid: Well, I didn't come for pizza. *[pauses]*

You might say I had a little run in withFRITO the BANDITO.

[Slings some Fritos]and I WON...haha.

Sheriff: You'd best be leaving Tombstone now, Silly the Kid.

Silly/ Kid: *[With a threatening air about him]*

What'd you say?!

Sheriff: I I I said Would you leave if you had a coke to go with that?

Silly/ Kid: WHY thanks.

[Takes the coke, then slowly pours it onto the boots of the Sheriff].

Sheriff: I'm warning you; Leave town.

Zorro: *[Arrives on scene; cape flipping in the wind]*

Sheriff, don't let Silly the Kid intimidate you!

The Bible, God's Word says: The Battle is the Lord's.

Silly/Kid: You challenging me MASKED MAN?!

Zorro: You've been ASKED to leave town Silly the Kid.

Silly/Kid: I Don't have to do anything! You can't make me ! I make my own rules!

I'm challenging you to a show-down SHERIFF ! RIGHT HERE NEXT SUNDAY!

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ACT THREE:

Characters: Zorro type character

Sheriff Big Hat Cowboy

Cowgirl Heroin

Silly the Kid/ Villain

Background Music Up: Suggest the Original *The Legend of Zorro Soundtrack* .
Running the music for at least 60 seconds sets the mood.

Cowgirl: [*Cowgirl is trying to reassure Sheriff*]

Put on this Gun Belt and Gun, Sheriff.

Sheriff: I ain't used to this sort of thing.

I've been challenged by Silly the Kid to a Show-Down.

I ain't never shot a gun before!

Cowgirl: There's a first time for everything!

Sheriff: Yeah, but I just don't want it to be my first AND my last !

Zorro: [*Appears cape waving & a Bible in one hand and a sword on his side*]

Have No Fear ! The Bible, God's Word, Says The Battle is the Lord's.

Sheriff: Easy for you to say! Silly the Kid didn't challenge you to a show-down.

Cowgirl: [*Pointing at the Bible in Zorro's hand*]

Can that Bible Shoot Straight, Zorro?

Zorro: THAT IT DOES !

Sheriff: Can that Bible win a show-down with Silly the Kid?

Zorro: It is Sharper than any two-edged sword.

Cowgirl: *[Reaches over and touches the Bible]*

Don't feel sharp to me.

Cowgirl: HERE HE COMES!

Music UP a little louder for just a moment.

Silly/ Kid: Sheriff Big Hat, I'm a calling you out!

Sheriff: *[Turns to Zorro]*

Let me have that Sword you got there, Zorro.

Zorro: *[Whips out sword and swings around everywhere]*

Sheriff: No, Not that one; THAT ONE. *[Reaches for the Bible]*

[Crowd Cheers]

Sheriff: Silly the Kid, you have broken the Law of God.

Silly/ Kid: HUH? You mean I am in trouble with GOD?!

Zorro: Yes, Silly the Kid, the Bible, God's Word says when you break one Law of God you have broken them ALL.

The Bible also says: Come let us reason together, though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow.

Silly/ Kid: You mean I can change !

Cowgirl: ONLY REPENTANCE brings about change, Silly the Kid.

Silly/ Kid: I need some of the repentance stuff you are talking about !

Zorro: The Bible God's Word says; Repent therefore and be converted that your sins be blotted out.
