


Assurance of Salvation

Luke 12: 23-32 Fear not, little flock, for it is the Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.


We are forgiven once saved:

Salvation Explained

But Jesus called them unto him, & said, Suffer little children to come unto me, & forbid them not; for of such is the kingdom of God. Luke 18:16

For ALL have sinned... Rom. 3:23

Everyone does things that are sinful, such as disobedience to parents, cheating, lying. God knew that you would be a sinner before you were born. **Once you realize**, that is, once you know that you are sinful, you are responsible to God for your sins. Heaven is a perfect place. If someone went to Heaven as a sinner, then Heaven would not be perfect any more. Therefore, an unforgiven sinner cannot go to Heaven.

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Rom. 6:23


The Bible says that our paycheck, that is, what we earn for sin, is death. This is the eternal death, the opposite of everlasting life in Heaven. Eternal death is eternity in the place called Hell. But you have a **gift** from God. He paid for your sins when He died on the cross, was buried, & came back to life on the third day. Just like any gift, you will have to take it & open it to make it yours. You have to accept this gift of eternal life in Heaven from Jesus Christ. He will not force you to take it.

...except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Luke 13:3

In order to accept the gift of eternal life, you must see a need to accept it. Jesus wants you to repent. To repent means to change or turn from your old ways. The only way you can change is to **let Jesus change you**.

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord, shall be saved. Rom.10:13

If you want to invite Jesus into your life, then you can pray and ask him. Here is a good way to ask Him: "Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. I am sorry for my sins. Please come into my heart and takeaway the sin. I know I can never be good enough to go to Heaven. So I am trusting you to take me when I die. I believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead to pay for my sins. I know you are the only way to Heaven. Amen."



What about Baptism?

If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. Acts 8:37

Water baptism by immersion followed salvation in the Bible.

Then they that gladly received his word were baptized. Acts 2:41

After a child has accepted Jesus as Savior, then baptism should follow as a picture of what has already happened in the heart. That is, acceptance of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.

We leave this decision of baptism with the parents and child. Most children are baptized within weeks of salvation.
