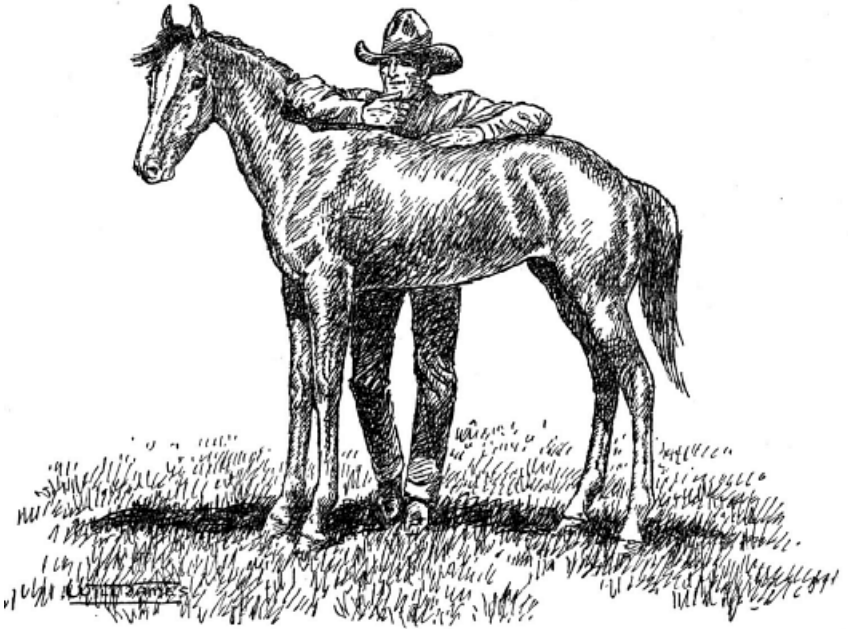

Who do you pray to?

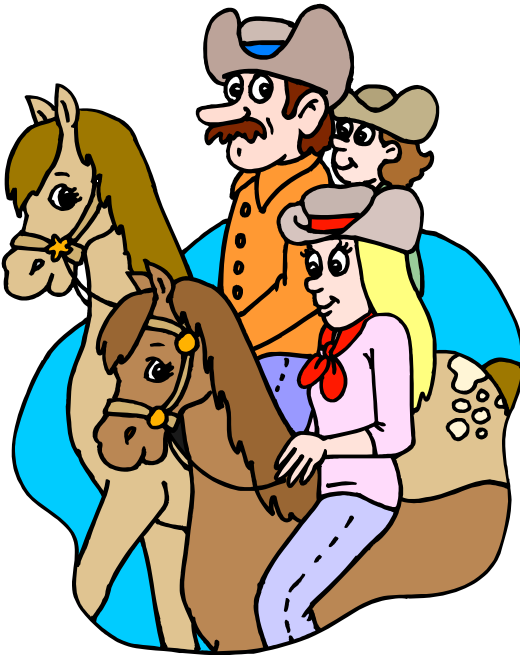


O, thou that hearest prayer.... *Psalm 65:2*

When you are born again, that is saved, then you are an adopted child of God and you can talk to Him like He is your Dad.

Abba is an old term for Daddy. But you must be adopted into the family for family privileges.

What do you pray ?



There are many things to prayer about.

The most important prayer of all makes you a child of God, that is born again, that is saved.

"For all have sinned..." Romans 3:23

Everyone does things that are wrong, such as disobedience to parents, cheating, lying. Once you realize, that is, once you know that you

are sinful, you are responsible to God for your sins. Heaven is a perfect place. If someone went to Heaven as a sinner, then Heaven would not be perfect any more. Therefore, an unforgiven sinner cannot go to Heaven.

God's Word says, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23

The Bible says that our paycheck, that is, what we earn for sin, is death. This is the eternal death, the opposite of everlasting life with Jesus in Heaven. Eternal death is eternity in Hell. But you have a gift from God. He paid for your sins when He died on the cross, was buried, and came back to life on the third day. Just like any gift, you will have to take it and open it to make it yours. You have to accept this gift of eternal life in Heaven from Jesus Christ. He will not force you to take it.

Luke 13:3 says, "...except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." In order to accept the gift of eternal life, you must see a need to accept it. Jesus wants you to repent, to change or turn from your old ways. The only way you can change is to let Jesus change you.

God says, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord, shall be saved." Romans 10:13

If you want to invite Jesus into your life, then you can pray and ask him. Here is a good way to ask Him: "Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. I am sorry for my sins. Please come into my heart and takeaway the sin. I know I can never be good enough to go to Heaven. So I am trusting you to take me when I die. I believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead to pay for my sins. I know you are the only way to Heaven. Amen."

After you are born again, that is saved, you will be still be tempted to do wrong things. Pray when you are tempted.

Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.
The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.

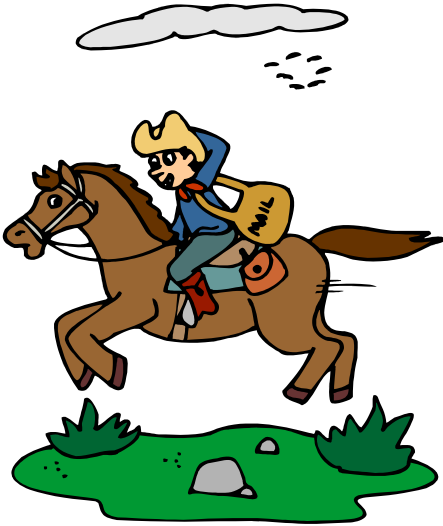


Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

How do you pray?

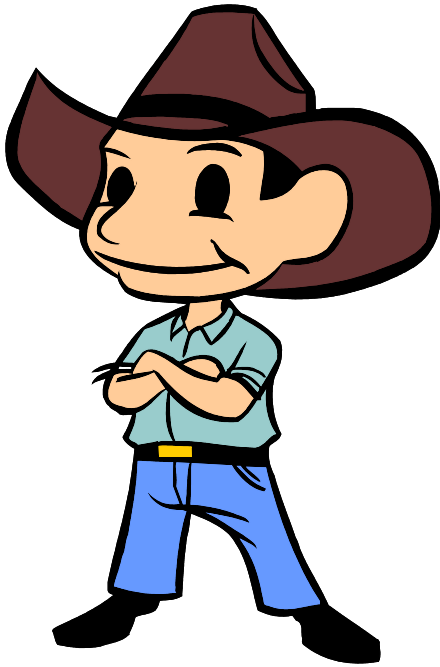
You can simply talk to Jesus.
