How to Know Heaven is your Home.....

The Bible, God's Word says, "For all have sinned..." Romans 3:23
Everyone does things that are wrong, such as disobedience to



authority, cheating, lying. God knew that you would be a sinner before you were even born.

Once you realize, that is, once you know that you are sinful, you are responsible to God for your sins. Heaven is a perfect place. If someone went to Heaven as a sinner, then Heaven would not be perfect any more. Therefore, an unforgiven sinner cannot go to Heaven.

The Bible, God's Word says,

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23

The Bible says that our paycheck, that is, what we earn for sin, is death. This is the eternal death, the opposite of everlasting life with Jesus in Heaven. Eternal death is eternity in Hell. But you have a gift from God. He paid for your sins when He died on the cross, was buried, and came back to life on the third day.

Just like any gift, you will have to take it and open it to make it yours. You have to accept this gift of eternal life in Heaven from Jesus Christ. He will not force you to take it.

The Bible, God's Word says, "...except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." Luke 13:3



In order to accept the gift of eternal life, you must see a need to accept it. Jesus wants you to repent.

To repent means to change or turn from your old ways. The only way you can change is to let Jesus change you.

The Bible, God's Word says, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord, shall be saved." Romans 10:13

If you want to invite Jesus into your life, then you can pray and ask him. Here is a good way to ask Him: "Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. I am sorry for my sins. Please come into my heart and takeaway the sin. I know I can never be good enough to go to Heaven. So I am trusting you to take me when I die. I believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead to pay for my sins. I know you are the only way to Heaven. Amen."

Building and Battling



- Once you have accepted Jesus as your Personal Savior, you will come under attack by the enemy.
- **BEFORE** you accept Jesus you simply **BELONG** to the enemy.

Read Nehemiah 4: 1-3

- You, too, may have to build with a shovel in one hand and a weapon in the other.
- Spiritual warfare goes after your mind, your hurt feelings, & makes it all about “YOU”.

How to combat that?

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

WEAPONS OF SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Peter used a sword to cut off the ear of the enemy. Was this effective? How did Jesus react?

What NEW & Different approach did he use to defeat the enemy in Book of Acts?

You have 3 Spiritual Enemies: The World, The Flesh, & The Devil



How will you defeat these?

2 Corinthians 10:4-5 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds; Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ...

Awarded the Purple Heart

Acts 6:5

... they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost

Stephen took a stand for Christ; it cost him his life. Even when you are doing **RIGHT**, you can be attacked.

Discuss Ways YOU can take a stand.

Defining Moment

*"...I will NOT let thee go except thou bless me"
Jacob's words moments before his name changed to ISRAEL.*

How to obtain the Blessing:

God does not let you run from your problems; he wants you to face them; repent of the wrong; and learn from the trouble **NO MATTER HOW LONG IT TAKES.**

How to obtain the Blessing:

Last Man Standing

Luke 17:26 And as it was in the days of Noah, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.

Jesus told us that one day you may be the ONLY person standing for Him in a group, a crowd, or even in your household. That is the way things were when Noah lived.



You can't run away from your peers, your coworkers, or even family members; but you don't have to join in with their sin either!

How to handle the everyday issues & still stand on the Word of God:

- Your co-workers are going out after work for a few cool ones; do you go? Or do you think about your testimony or your personal walk with the Savior?
- You are at a family gathering & pressured to "join in" the unseemly joke telling. See Luke 12:3
- At work you are told to falsify information on a report; do you do it or do you go home asking God to intervene or to find you a new job?
- At the Ranch Rodeo Event, another "team" member is "fudging" a little on the rules; a little bending is all right, after all it's just a game. What do you do?

John 10:15b ...I lay down my life for the sheep.



Jesus gave His all.

Sheets can be double sided run to use only three 8 ½ x 11 sheets.

Use card stock for the Cover.

Layout is as follows:

- Back to Back WHW pages 6 & 3 runs back to back with pages 4-5 [Center pages with Puzzle]
 - Back to Back WHW pages 2 & 7 runs back to back with pages 1 & 8.
 - Back to Back WHW Cover runs on Card Stock back to back with FLIP OF COVER document.
1. Place on a flat surface so that cover will be on the outside.
 2. Place pages so that numerical sequences will be in order once folded in half.
 3. Simply staple in the center fold with a long reach stapler.
